


GETTING STARTED WITH GOOGLE SCHOLAR

WHAT IS GOOGLE SCHOLAR?

OC users can access licensed database and journal content through [Google Scholar](#). Look for the "Get it from OC" links to connect through OC.

SET-UP LIBRARY LINKS

1. Go to [Google Scholar](#)
2. Click the the cog icon  to see Settings for your Google account
3. Click Library Links and search for Okanagan College
4. Check the boxes next to "Okanagan College" links
5. Click save


'Get it from OC' links will now appear next to articles in search results available through OC library. Click the link to gain access.
