## PREAMBLE:

Employees who are eligible for group benefits will be referred to an electronic Group Benefits guide on the Human Resources section of its website.

## PROCEDURE:

- 1. When an employee is eligible for group benefit coverage with Okanagan College, s/he will be provided instructions on how to access an electronic benefit guide with employee group-specific information.
- The Group Benefits guide contains comprehensive details regarding life insurance, accidental death & dismemberment, long term disability (if applicable), extended health and dental coverage.
- 3. Where changes have been made to group benefit coverage either through collective bargaining or policy or legislation, Human Resources will distribute communications to employees impacted by the change(s).
