PREAMBLE:

OC provides a credit towards workload for continuing College Professors and Vocational Instructors who have an assigned workload involving travel between campuses or centres.

PROCEDURE:

1. Faculty - College Professors

- a. Travel time to an adjacent campus is credited as one hour each way.
- b. Travel time to a non-adjacent campus is credited as two hours each way.

2. Vocational Instructors

When a Vocational Instructor from one centre is assigned duties at another centre, each two hours of travel time between centres shall equal one assigned duty hour. The formula is as follows:

actual travel time / 2

The following table details the actual travel time amounts to be used in the calculation of workload credit for Vocational Instructors:

- 3. While term College Professors and non-regular Vocational Instructors do not get workload credit for travel time they do receive travel expenses for the kilometres that they travel between campuses and/or centres.
- 4. Employees do not receive workload credit or travel expenses between their home and their assigned campus.
