Verification of Enrolment

The Office of the Registrar is working with IT Services on a self-service application that allows students to download their verification of enrolment (VOE), previously called a confirmation of enrolment. The VOE will follow national standards laid out by the Association of Registrars of Universities and Colleges Canada (ARUCC).

Currently we are piloting the VOE for international students whereby we create the VOE, rather than the student. This is how we will find and correct any issues before we go live. We hope to have the self-serve option available to most students in the next few months.
