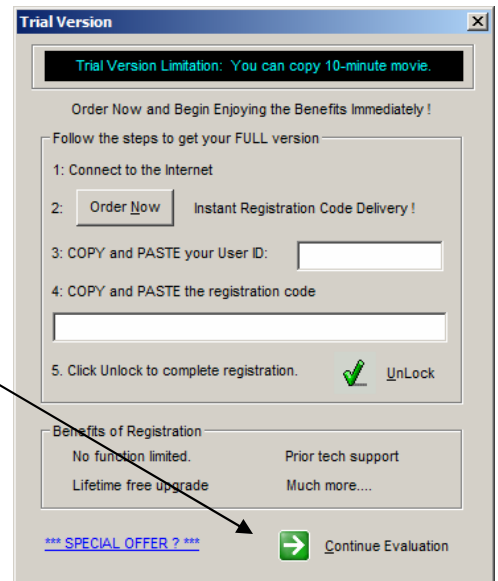
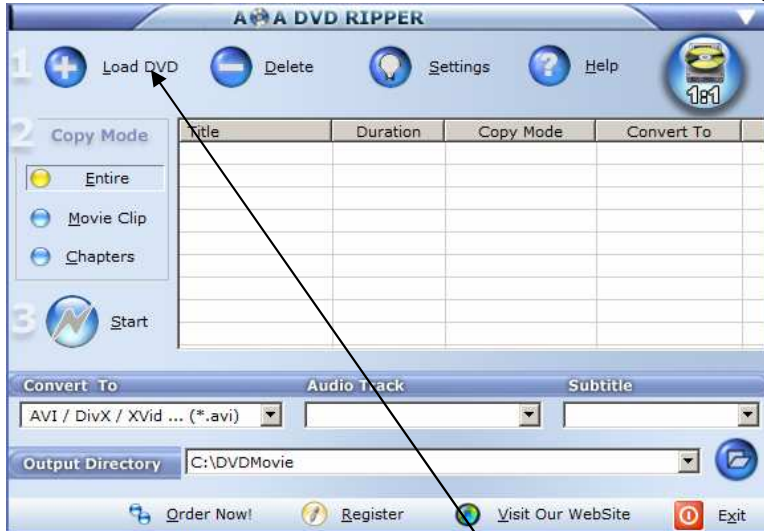
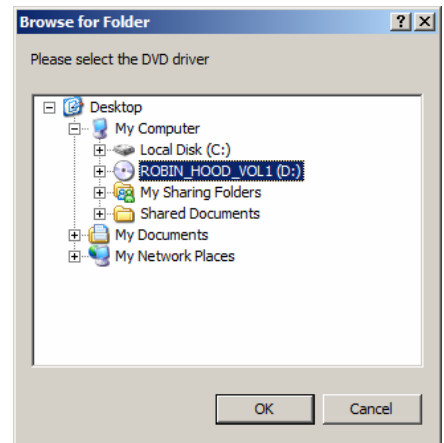


**Putting a clip from a DVD into Powerpoint.**

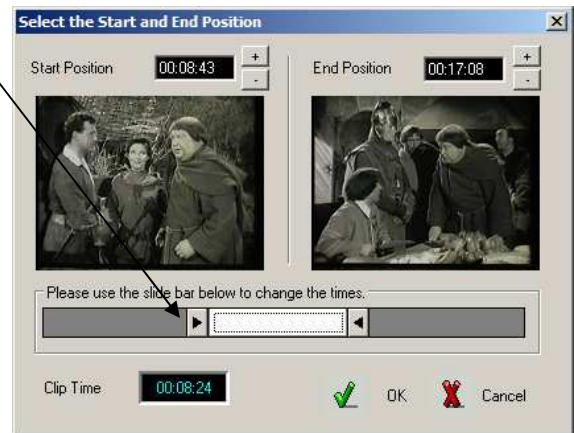
1. Download and install the trial version of AOA DVD Ripper.
2. Launch AOA DVD Ripper. Click Continue Evaluation.



3. Place your DVD in the drive and click Load DVD. Select Import from DVD disk and locate your DVD.



4. Click on Movie Clip. Slide the triangles to the start and end of the clip you want. You can click the + and - signs to fine-tune your selection to the second. Note: the trial version is limited to 10 minutes.



5. Click OK to confirm your selection. Under Convert To you can choose file format and frame size. The default (AVI, 720x480) works fine but the files are large - WMV 320x240 or MPG 352x240 also work well. Click on Settings to see what you're getting.



6. Click Start to begin encoding. Be sure to have a look at the output directory to see where to find your clip.

The program may ask you to click Continue Evaluation again. You'll get a display showing the progress of the encoding.

7. Open your Powerpoint presentation. Pull down File to Insert Movies and Sounds to Movie from File. Locate your clip and put it in.
