

Embedding video on a web page.

Creating a web page to play a .wmv file.

Create a movie (using something like Windows Movie Maker)

Save it as a .wmv at 320x240 pixels.

Launch a web editor (like Nvu - free download from nvu.com)

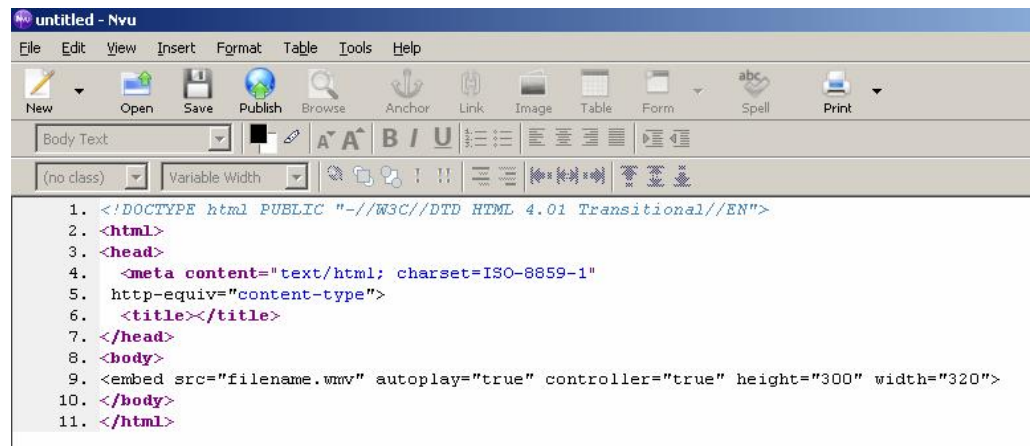
Click on Source at the bottom of the screen to view the html coding.

in between the <body> and </body> tags insert the following:

```
<embed src="filename.wmv" autoplay="true" controller="true" height="300" width="320">
```

Save the web page and load it on the web. Be sure to load the .wmv file in the same directory as the page.

*notes: you need to add about 60 pixels to the height to accommodate the controller.



Creating a web page to play a quicktime movie.

Create a movie (using something like iMovie)

Save it as a quicktime movie at 320x240 pixels.

Launch a web editor (like Nvu - free download from nvu.com)

Click on Source at the bottom of the screen to view the html coding.

in between the <body> and </body> tags insert the following:

```
<embed src="filename.wmv" autoplay="true" controller="true" height="256" width="320">
```

Save the web page and load it on the web. Be sure to load the .wmv file in the same directory as the page.

*notes: you need to add 16 pixels to the height to accommodate the controller.
