

## Creating a Flash Video for WebCT

### Encoding a Flash Video

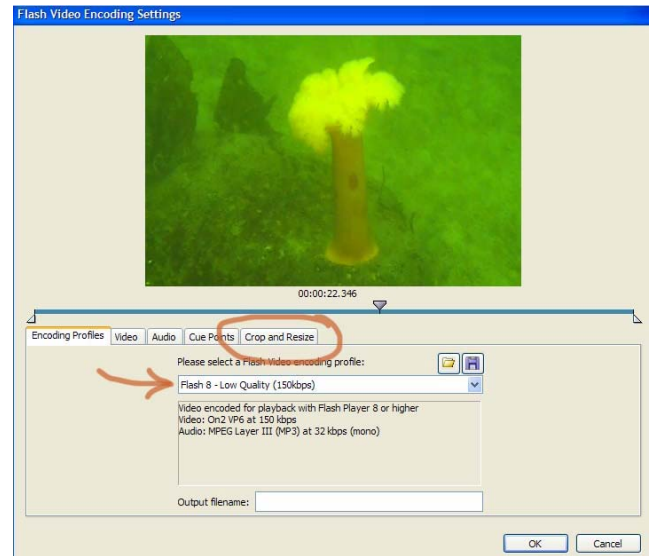
Open the Program **Adobe Flash CS3 Video Encoder**

Click on **Add**

Browse for the video file you want to encode. Click **Open**  
Click on the **Settings..** Button. Under **Encoding Profiles** Select  
which type of Flash File you want for example (Flash 7- Low  
Quality). Smaller video files work best for WebCT. Adjust the  
Video size under **Crop and Resize** adjust the video size to **320 x  
240**. Once you have adjusted all the settings, Type your Output  
filename.

Click on **OK** button, Click **Start Queue**

Video will appear in bottom right corner. When the video has  
finished encoding it will display a green check mark.



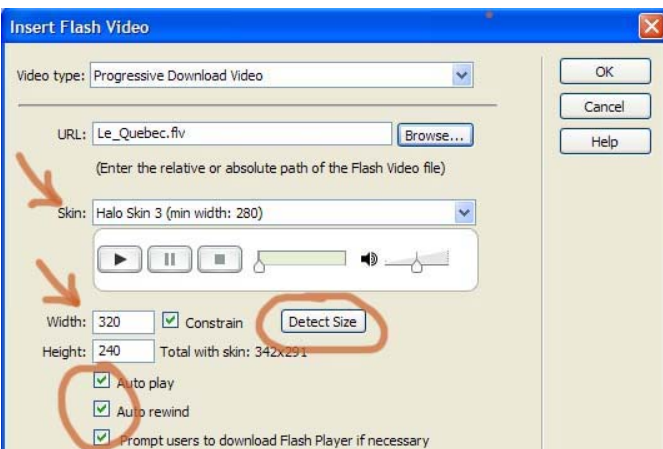
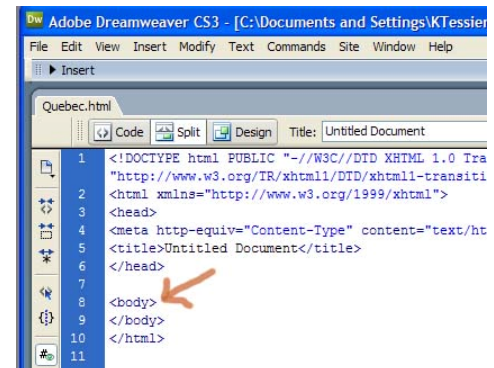
### Embedding a Flash Video into an HTML file

Open **Adobe Dreamweaver CS3**

It is best to create a folder to store your **HTML webpage**, and your **Flash video** files.

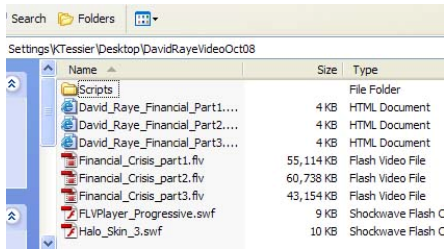
Create an HTML page by Clicking **File, New**. Select **HTML**, Click on the  
**Create** button. Save your page into the file folder you just created.

Insert the Flash Video into the HTML code window by placing the cursor  
right after the **<body>** tag. Click on **Insert, Media , Flash Video**.



When the **Insert Flash Video** Dialogue box appears, click on  
**Browse** to locate your video, select a **Skin** from drop down  
menu, Click on **Detect Size**, then click on the little square box  
beside both **Auto play**, and **Auto rewind**. Click **OK** button

To **Preview** the Flash and HTML page click on the **small world icon**  
on the **menu bar** and select a browser. The video should  
play automatically. If this **message** appears - To help protect  
your security....Click here for options, Click on **message**, Click  
on **Allow Blocked Content**. When the **Security Warning**  
dialogue box appears click **Yes**.



## Adding your Video into WebCT

Make sure all the **files** you need are in the same folder. Dreamweaver automatically creates the **Script files** and the other files needed to play your video.

**Zip your folder by right clicking on your mouse, select Send To and select Compressed (zipped) Folder.**

Import **Zipped folder** into **WebCT** using **Control panel manage files. Unzip folder**
