



Ed Tech Tools for Student Response

Socrative

Go to www.socrative.com and sign up for a free account.

Give your room a name.

Students will go to m.socrative.com (computer or mobile device)

They will enter the room number (or name) and click Join Room.

(* There is a free iPhone app for Teacher and Student – works great)

To ask a single question, click Multiple Choice, True/False or Short Answer.

Verbally ask the question - or display the question on the screen as part of your presentation and have students enter their responses on their devices.

You can vote on short answers.

In Manage Quizzes you can pre-build quizzes.

Then you run them in Quiz Based Activities.

Quizzes can be student paced or teacher paced.

An Exit Ticket is a fixed set of 4 questions:

Name?

How well did you understand today's material?

What did you learn today

Please solve the problem on the board

The teacher can download or email the results (excel file)

You can't edit this Exit Ticket but you can build your own quiz and use it instead.

Space Race is a competition. Students in groups answer questions to get their rocketship to the finish line first.
