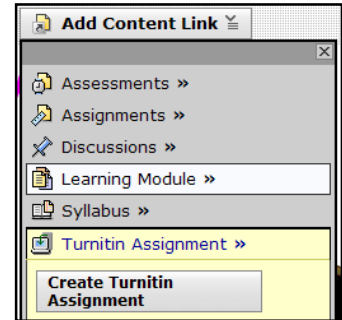
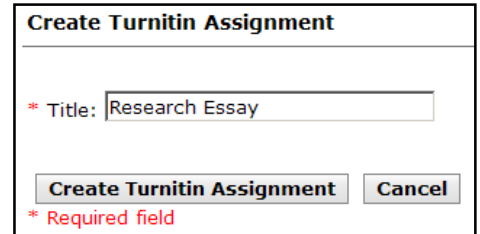


Creating a turnitin assignment in Blackboard CE 8

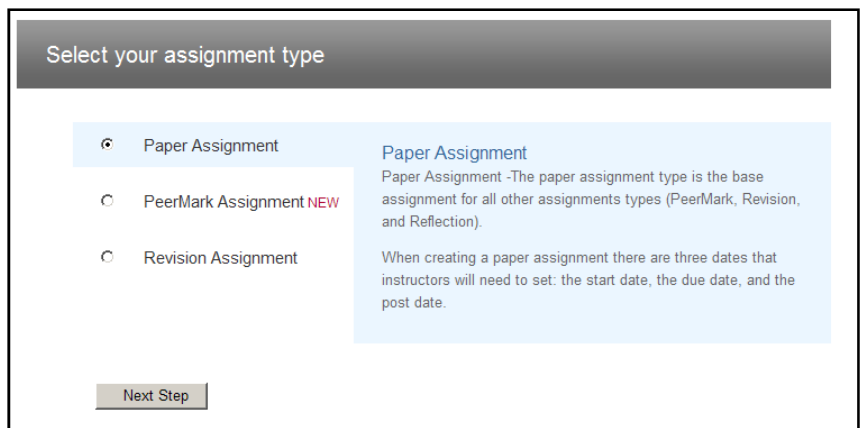
In the build tab, pull down Add Content Link to Turnitin Assignment to Create Turnitin Assignment.



Give the link a title and click Create Turnitin Assignment. (again)



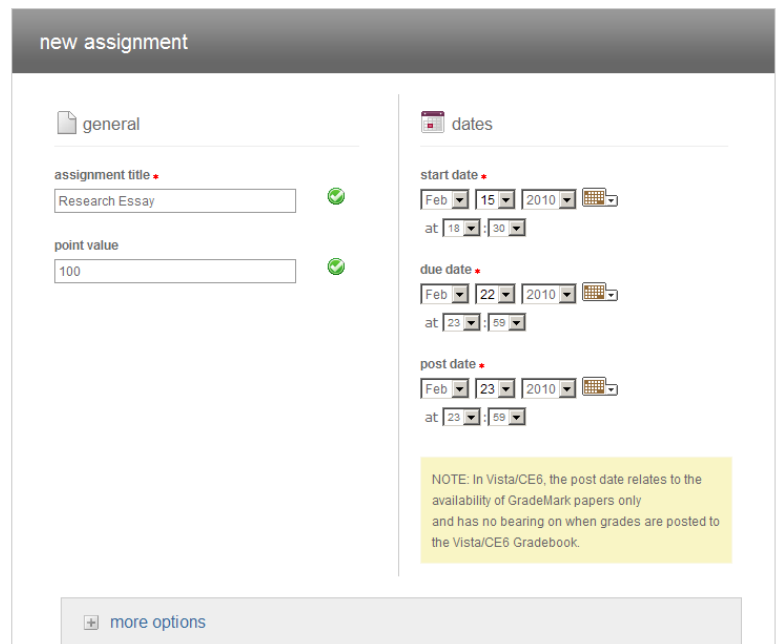
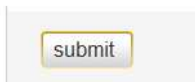
Select Paper Assignment and click Next.



Enter your assignment title (again) and the point value. Set the start date and due date. Open 'more options' to customize the turnitin settings.

You can choose to exclude bibliographic and quoted content, and decide whether students can see the originality report.

At the bottom of the page click Submit.




Reviewing a turnitin assignment.

In the teach tab click the turnitin assignment you created.

You will see your turnitin assignment inbox with papers that have been submitted.


Click the report bar graph to see the detailed report.
