

## Campus-to-Campus open for sign-ups

Registration is now open for the first major Okanagan road race of the new decade – the Okanagan College's Campus-to-Campus race series – set for March 28 in Kelowna.

The race, in its eighth year of operation, will offer runners a half marathon, half marathon relay and a 10-km race.

With a goal of increasing community, student and staff participation, the college offers races varying in length and difficulty – from a 4-km relay portion; to a 10-km race; to a 21.1-km half marathon.

Also new this year is an out-and-back course beginning at the KLO Road campus of Okanagan College. The half marathon course will turn around atop the first hill on Knox Mountain. Runners will then make their way back the KLO campus.
