# Spring Break camps offer learning and fun at KLO campus

Children in Grades 3-6 have their choice of the following two camps will run

during the week of March 17 to 20, and each camp has a \$158 registration fee.

Egyptian Week will offer campers the chance to travel to the fascinating world of Ancient Egypt without ever leaving the classroom! Murmies, pyramids and tombs are just a few things you will discover.

Babysitter Training will get your child ready for that summer job. Practical experience in holding, changing diapers and dressing a baby or child are all included. Successful candidates will become a Red Cross trained

The themes for week 2, (March 25 to 28) for Grades 3-6 will be:

- Wizards Academy where children will discover how a broom flies, decode a secret message, taste a sip of "butter beer", eat chocolate covered frogs and create potions, wands, hats and a book of science spells.
- Wizards Return is calling

all wizards as we harness the power of imagination to connect edible potions, create sludge and practice charms.

Teenagers in Grades 7-9 can participate in the following two camps, which cost \$228 per week:

March 17-20—Web Page Design will teach students to launch their own website using their own unique personality. The more adven-

turous will be encouraged to be creative and use simple Macromedia Flash to make the site really cool and creative. Graduates take home their website on a CD!

March 25-28—Flash Animation and Multi-Media Design will let your child's creative mind take over! Campers will learn how to take any photo and turn it into digital artwork. Participants will

use leading edge Macromedia Flash software to design an awesome slide show, short animated movie, or a splashy web page. At the end create a digital art slide show or photo artwork on CD to send to friends and family.
