

What will your kids do on spring break

Haven't figured out yet what you'll do with the kids during spring break?

Well, Okanagan College is offering fun and educational camps for boys and girls from Grades 3 to 9.

Each camp is 9 a.m.-3:30 p.m. for four weekdays at the KLO campus. Camps will not run on statutory holidays over Easter. Every participant will have a chance to learn new skills and make new friends.

Children in Grades 3-6 have their choice of two camps on March 17-20 at a cost of \$158:

— **Egyptian Week** will focus on the ancient world with the history of mummies, pyramids and tombs.

— **Babysitter Training** will involve practical experience in holding babies, changing diapers and dressing a baby or child with certification by the Red Cross.

Week 2 camps March 25-28 for Grades 3-6 are:

— **Wizards Academy** where children will discover how a broom flies, decode a secret message, taste a sip of butter beer, eat chocolate-covered frogs and create potions, wands, hats and a book of science spells.

— **Wizards Return** offers instruction in edible potions, creating sludge and practising charms.

Teens in Grades 7-9 have their choice of two camps at \$228 per week:

— March 17-20, **Web Page Design** will teach students to launch their own website and use Macromedia Flash. Graduates can take their website home on a CD.

— March 25-28, **Flash Animation and Multimedia Design** will teach teens how to turn any photo into digital artwork and design a slide show, a short animated movie or a web page. CDs can be sent to friends and family at the end.
