everyone, the

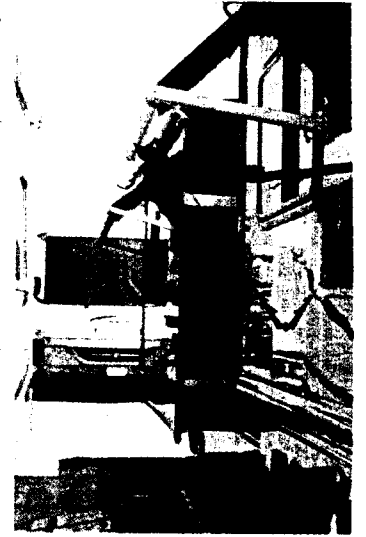
seminar covers the
