BY-ELECTION TO EDUCATION COUNCIL: Student

ES-2

One eligible student from the Central Okanagan region.

1. Any student shall be considered eligible, within defined constituent groups, to
 - a) stand for election to one student seat on the Board of Governors or Education Council, but not both, if registered in course or program leading to a certificate, diploma or degree approved by Education Council and if deemed to be in good standing, as determined by the Registrar.
A student is deemed to be in good standing provided that the student is not currently on probation and provided that the student has not been placed on default with respect to payment of assessed fees
 - b) nominate other student(s) to stand for election to a student seat on the Board or the Education Council, and
 - c) vote in an election or by-election to determine student representative(s) to the Board and Education Council.
