please continue to support us until Monday," said Annand.

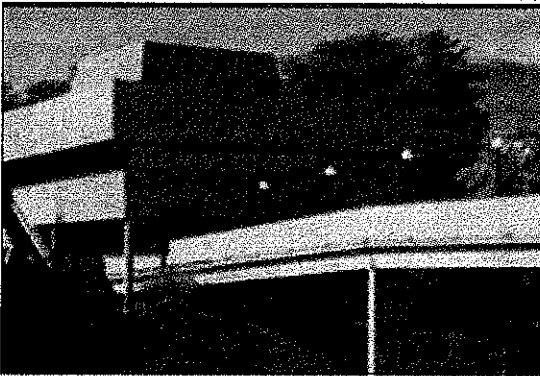
