OK Falls man joins college board

An experienced construction project management professional is the latest addition to the Okanagan College board of governors.

W. Tom Styffe, of Okanagan Falls has been appointed by the provincial government to a one-year term on the college board.

Styffe is semi-retired after a career in construction project management that spanned more than three decades. His work included projects ranging from the \$25-million New Westminster campus of Douglas College to schools, hospitals, commercial projects and more than 1,000 units of residential construction.

He's serving his second term as an alternate director for the Regional District of Okanagan-Similkameen and has been active in municipal and provincial politics, including serving as a councillor for Logan Lake.

"I'm very excited by this opportunity," said Styffe. "I'm looking forward to contributing to the development and growth of Okanagan College."
