### Classes cut at college

Okanagan College's continuing education brochure for 1985 will have 100 fewer courses than this year.

Those being eliminated are the general interest, non-credit courses which haven't been that popular, the ones not providing the college with sufficient revenue to warrant their continuation.

"We're not really pleased about the decisions we've had to make, but those are the kind of times we're in," said David Wood, a regional director for the college, whose own position is being eliminated.

There's very little choice to be made, he said.
