

# Spaghetti Bridge Building Contest Prize List 2010

## Secondary competition

The five lightest bridges to survive the loading test will be ranked by weight

- 1<sup>st</sup> prize \$150 plus trophy
- 2<sup>nd</sup> prize \$100
- 3<sup>rd</sup> prize \$50
- 4<sup>th</sup> prize \$40
- 5<sup>th</sup> prize \$30

## Post Secondary competition

The five lightest bridges to survive the loading test will be ranked by weight

- 1<sup>st</sup> prize \$150 plus trophy
- 2<sup>nd</sup> prize \$100
- 3<sup>rd</sup> prize \$50
- 4<sup>th</sup> prize \$40
- 5<sup>th</sup> prize \$30

## Team competition

The top finalists will be awarded prizes as follows:

### Secondary Division

- 1<sup>st</sup> prize \$100 per student up to a maximum of \$400 per team, plus trophy
- 2<sup>nd</sup> prize \$75 per student up to a maximum of \$300 per team
- 3<sup>rd</sup> prize \$50 per student up to a maximum of \$200 per team

### Post secondary Division

- 1<sup>st</sup> prize \$100 per student up to a maximum of \$400 per team, plus trophy
- 2<sup>nd</sup> prize \$75 per student up to a maximum of \$300 per team
- 3<sup>rd</sup> prize \$50 per student up to a maximum of \$200 per team

## Heavyweight Competition

The top five bridges in terms of load supported during the loading test will be ranked according to maximum load and awarded prizes accordingly. In the case of identical load supported, preference will be given to the lighter bridge. To be eligible for a prize, the bridge must support at least 10 kg.

- 1<sup>st</sup> prize \$1,500 plus trophy
- 2<sup>nd</sup> prize \$1,000
- 3<sup>rd</sup> prize \$500
- 4<sup>th</sup> prize Okanagan College bookstore gift certificate
- 5<sup>th</sup> prize Okanagan College bookstore gift certificate

**Note:** One award only per builder in each competition.
