REWARDING EXCELLENCE CNAB Program Accreditation



CARS believes that the maintenance of high quality training programs is essential to the stability of the motive power repair and service industry. In this edition of CARS News, we take a closer look at the value of nationally accredited programs.

The accreditation process developed by CARS supports the delivery of state-of-the-technology motive power education and training by enabling educational institutions to voluntarily submit post-secondary motive power programs to an independent, industry-driven auditing process. This process determines if programs meet national standards of program excellence or if any improvements or adjustments are required.

The CARS National Accreditation Board establishes, maintains and reviews all policies, procedures and standards pertaining to national program accreditation. The CNAB also conducts site visits and grants national accreditation status to those programs found to be in full compliance with the prescribed program delivery standards.

The CNAB has recently joined the Association of Accrediting Agencies of Canada (AAAC), an organization whose members accredit a variety of professions, including engineers, nurses, dentists, dietitians, pharmacists and occupational therapists. The mission of the AAAC is to pursue excellence in standards and processes of accreditation in order to ensure the highest quality education of professionals in Canada.
