The curriculum follows the BC Ministry of Advanced Education guidelines for the first-year in-class components of the Electrician Apprenticeship, which includes installation procedures in compliance with the Canadian Electrical Code for residential, commercial and industrial systems.

Five Steps to Enrol

1. Fill out a pre-apprenticeship application form online at <http://www.okanagan.bc.ca/registrar/admissions/apply.html> or drop by the Salmon Arm Campus. The application fee is \$30.
2. Request and complete the practice entrance English and math reading skills practice test. Ask the staff for help if you need further practice or assistance.
3. Schedule a time write the entrance test. The testing fee is \$25.
4. Upon successful completion of the entrance test, you will be sent an offer of admission by mail. A \$200 deposit will secure your seat.
5. Full tuition fees are due July 22, 2011. Contact Financial Aid for information regarding bursaries and scholarships.
