

Okanagan School of Business dean transitions into new role

The first dean of the Okanagan School of Business and one of Okanagan College's longest-serving employees is taking on the newly created role of director, learning and teaching.

Dr. Jayne Brooks has spent the last year in an interim role developing the position, which includes providing leadership for the college's Institute for Learning and Teaching.

Brooks said that learner-centred instruction is the college's focus and its aim is to enhance learning and teaching methods to help students and employees at-

tain their goals.

Brooks is an alumna of the college's Business Administration program and served on the

Program Advisory committee after graduation.

She spent 20 years in the classroom teaching and was dean of the Okanagan School of Business for 10 years.

Brooks has received numerous awards, including being the first recipient of the Okanagan University College Distinguished Alumni Award and the YWCA's Women of Distinction Award for Career Leadership.
