Bachelor of Social Work programs at BC Universities vary in their admission requirements for entrance to **YEAR THREE (3)**. Most programs require 60 transferable credits with some programs accepting varying numbers of discretionary credit from the Okanagan College's Human Service Worker program. The following courses should cover all BSW admission requirements:

- ENGL 100
- ENGL 150 or 151 or 153
- SOCW 200A
- SOCW 200B
- WMST 100
- INDG 100
