

# Collaborate – Mapping a Lesson Online

#### **Establish Routines**

Welcome, provide LO's, agenda

#### Pre-assess

 Pre-class forum posts, brainstorm in groups or pairs, Moodle quiz, online quiz tools, poll

# Deliver Theory

• Lecture, watch a film or simulation, play a podcast, have students read independently, invite guest speakers

## Engage Learners

 Student presentations, questions in the chat, breakout groups, interactive whiteboards, case studies, debates

#### Post-assess

 Complete a reflection, forum or equations posted on Moodle, host virtual office hours, post supplemental material
