# 5.1 Curriculum recommended by the CPRC - AFP

#### a. New course: CMNS 265 Environmental Communications

### b. Course revision: SOCI 271 Statistical Analysis in Sociology

That Education Council approves the course revision: SOCI 271 Statistical Analysis in Sociology as recommended by the CPRC – AFP:

- R Huxtable explained that the course will improve the way statistics is offered based on the changes in the lab component.
- P Lefebvre noted that the course was rolling out as having a lab component. This would be an improvement as students will receive extra attention.

- B Penfound asked whether there was a specific tool that will be used for the lab section.
- P Lefebvre responded in the affirmative, noting that the lab time/component will be used to apply formulas and would complement the lecture and theoretical aspects.

### c. Program revision: Adult Basic Education

That Education Council approves the program revision: Adult Basic education as recommended by the CPRC – AFP:

- N Befus explained that not much was changed, just the language 'cleaned up' based on feedback that some areas were not clear. One such was the 5 years rule.
- The department has made the 5 years rule applicable for all prerequisites, this is the primary change.
- The Math, English and Science areas were also separated.
- A Krebs sought clarification on the start dates relating to the program and whether there might be an error.
- N Befus agreed that there was an error and the dates in the new language should be changed to reflect:

Kelowna – September, January, May and July Revelstoke – September and January

Penticton, Salmon Arm and Vernon - September, January and May

- J Ragsdale suggested that it might be helpful to have an education advising schedule on some campus sites.
- R Huxtable asked for clarification on the relationship between Adult Basic Education and Adult upgrading.
- N Befus clarified that the program that is changing is ABE, while Adult Upgrading is the department.
