



# Upgrading English Course Options

(Okanagan College, Salmon Arm Campus)

## Fundamental

### English 50 (51-52) and English 60 (61-62)

*Grades 4-9 Equivalent*

This level is for students who wish to obtain basic reading, writing, and mathematics skills.

## Intermediate

### English 70

*Grade 10 Equivalent*

This level prepares students for Advanced courses or college programs that have a prerequisite of grade 10 English.

## Advanced

### English 80

*Grade 11 Equivalent*

This level prepares students for Provincial level courses and for many Okanagan College certificate and diploma programs requiring a high school diploma or equivalent.

## Provincial

### English 12

*Grade 12 Equivalent*

This is the highest level of English study offered by the AU Department and prepares students for admission to certificate, diploma, and degree programs that have an English 12 pre-requisite.

English 012	Skills Assessment or English 080* or English 11* or Composition 011* or Literacy Studies 11* or Literary Studies & Writing 11*

\*A **minimum grade of 60%** is required unless otherwise stated.

### \*What is a Prerequisite?

In Latin *pre* means "before" and *requisite* means "require" therefore, prerequisite means required beforehand.

Thus, prerequisites are courses that students must have already successfully completed before registering in another course.

All course prerequisites must have been completed *within 5 years* of the start of the course.
