Graduation requires successful completion of the prescribed and elective courses as listed in the program outline above. 30 credits must be taken at OC, of which 15 must be at the 200 level or higher. A minimum graduating grade average (GGA) of 60% is required for the courses taken at Okanagan College being used to satisfy the required 60 credits for the diploma.

The elective you choose here will be determined by your chosen concentration at UBCO. Be prepared with the right electives.
