


Okanagan College Total Headcount by Academic Year



Qualifying Notes - Headcount

- 1. Student headcount results are reported by academic year (September 1 to August 31).
 - a. Students are only counted once in an academic year regardless of the number of courses and/or programs they are enrolled in within the given year.
 - b. Student headcount represents the number of students registered in all reported instructional activity, including skills courses (e.g. community education) and developmental activity (e.g. qualifying/remedial).
- 2. Students who pay an international fee for at least one course in the fiscal year period reported are deemed to be international students.
- 3. Indigenous learners are students with Indigenous ancestry who self-identify as Indigenous, First Nations, Metis, or Inuit in the BC K-12 education system or at a BC public post-secondary institution. The Non-Indigenous category may include Indigenous learners who have not self-identified.
- 4. Data Source: BC Central Data Warehouse (CDW).


High School Graduate Immediate Transitions to BC Post-Secondary Institutions Okanagan College Region



Qualifying Notes – High School Transitions

- 1. The above chart displays Okanagan College (OC) Region high school graduates and whether they immediately transitioned to a BC Post Secondary Institution (PSI).
- 2. Students are considered to have made an *Immediate Transition* to a BC PSI if they enrolled in a BC PSI within one year of graduating high school.
- 3. Students are reported under their *PSI Academic Year of Entry*, indicating that they graduated from an OC Region high school in the prior year. Academic year is defined as September 1 to August 31.
 - a. For example, consider the 2021-22 Academic Year:
 - 666 students graduated from an OC Region high school in the 2020-21 school year and immediately transitioned to Okanagan College in 2021-22. 939 students graduated from an OC Region high school in the 2020-21 school year and immediately transitioned to a non-OC BC PSI in 2021-22. Finally, 2,090 students graduated from an OC Region high school in the 2020-21 school year and did not immediately transition to a BC PSI in 2021-22.
- 4. Immediate transition rates are provided for both OC Region Grads transitioning to OC and OC Region Grads transitioning to any BC PSI (including OC).
- 5. An overall BC immediate transition rate is also provided for comparison purposes. This metric displays the percentage of all BC high school graduates who immediately transitioned to any BC PSI in a given academic year.

Qualifying Notes - FTEs

- 1. Full-Time Equivalent (FTE) results are reported by fiscal year (April 1 to March 31).
 - a. FTEs are generated by students who are enrolled in instructional activity and are calculated based on the student's program at the time of their enrolment in the course section.
 - b. Student FTEs are comprised of all reported instructional activity, including students enrolled in skills courses (e.g. community education) and developmental activity (e.g. qualifying/remedial).
- 2. Students who pay an international fee for at least one course in the fiscal year period reported are deemed to be international students.
- 3. Data Source: BC Central Data Warehouse (CDW).
