Proposal Rationale

The Department wants to remove CMNS 112 and CMNS 122 from the BCIS program because:

- CMNS 112/122 and CMNS 113/123 bear almost no similarity except in the most basic sense (i.e. universal best practices of professional/workplace writing).

- CMNS 113/123 are targeted at CIS students specifically and therefore focus on professional

communication skills necessary for professional success in IT (i.e. not just a focus on technical documents but also the important skill of knowing how to translate technical information into language accessible to a lay audience. This is especially important since many COSC students begin their careers as support technicians.)

- CMNS 113/123 have learning outcomes that set them up for success in COSC courses that have a communication component (i.e. COSC 126 that has a focus on documentation and includes a final presentation; The COSC 205 and 224 has said previously that she noticed an improvement in student success after the course project in CMNS 123 was revised to align with the communication outcomes in COSC 126.)

- COSC students are introduced to IEEE in CMNS 123; the only overlap between CMNS 122 & CMNS 123 is learning how to research and use sources, but CMNS 122 focuses on APA, not IEEE. CMNS 112/122 are meant for business students, so examples and assignments are based on this premise; the content covered in CMNS 113/123 is tailored to students entering careers in IT (i.e. sample documents always have a technical component).

- Students don't learn how to write resumes/cover letters in CMNS 112/122.
